To prepare and package items being sent out to both engineers and customers. To produce delivery notes for these items and arrange collections with the relevant logistics companies	To deal with a range of stakeholders including logistics companies, engineers, service coordinators to achieve best outcomes for the business
To deal with telephone and email queries as they arise	To support with deliveries and collections of equipment as required
To move stock around the warehouses using the most effective tool for the task i.e., sack truck, pallet truck, lift truck	To undertake other duties related to the nature of the job and its level of responsibility
